

**NOTICE OF HEARING**  
**On Petition for Enlargement of Herd**  
**District No. 1 and also for Changing**  
**Time When Said Herd District**  
**Will Be In Effect.**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on June 28, 1938, a petition was filed in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Pondera County, Montana, this petition praying for certain additions and enlargement of this district by the addition of certain tracts of land to same, and also that the time when said Herd District No. 1 is to be in effect be changed. The afore-mentioned petition was presented for the consideration of the Board of County Commissioners of Pondera County, Montana at the regular session of said Board held on Tuesday, July 5, 1938, same reading as follows:

**"TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF**  
**COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF**  
**PONDERA COUNTY, MONTANA:**

We, the undersigned owners or possessors of fifty-five per cent (55%) of the land in Herd District No. 1, created July 7, 1919, and containing approximately 63,360 acres, taking in a rectangular piece of land running nine (9) miles west and eleven (11) miles south of the Northeast corner of Section Eleven (11), Township Thirty (30) North, Range Two (2) West, do hereby petition your Honorable Board to change the dates that said Herd District shall be in effect, in accordance with the law as enacted by the Twenty-second (22nd) Legislative Assembly of the State of Montana, as set forth in Chapter 78 of the Session Laws of said Assembly.

Said Herd District is in effect from the first day of May to the first day of November of each year.

We request that the above dates be changed so that the said Herd District No. One (1) shall be in effect from the first day of January to the Thirty-first (31st) day of December inclusive of each and every year, and that this district be enlarged to include the tier of sections one mile north of said north line, as per map attached; i. e., Secs. 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6, T. 30 N., R. 2 W., and Secs. 1, 2, and 3, T. 30 N., R. 3 W."

NOW, THEREFORE, Notice is hereby given that the date of Thursday, August 4th, A. D. 1938, at 10:00 o'clock A. M., at the Commissioners' Room in the Court House at Conrad, Montana, is duly set by the Board of County Commissioners of Pondera County for the purpose of verifying the signatures affixed to said petition, and also for the purpose of hearing protests, if any, against the granting of same.

Burns, Undertaker, Shelby, Montana, for the burial of a transient who died on a Great Northern train, was ordered disallowed in full by the Board, for the reason that this burial was not authorized by the Board of County Commissioners of this County.
